Elizabeth Zachariadou is retired Professor of Turkish Studies in the Department of History and Archaeology of the University of Crete, where she taught from 1985 to 1998. Since 1987 she has been responsible for the Programme of Turkish Studies at the Institute for Mediterranean Studies, where she now holds the title of Honorary Fellow. In 1990 she was awarded an honorary doctorate by the University of Ankara. Since 1993 she has been a member of Academia Europaea.
